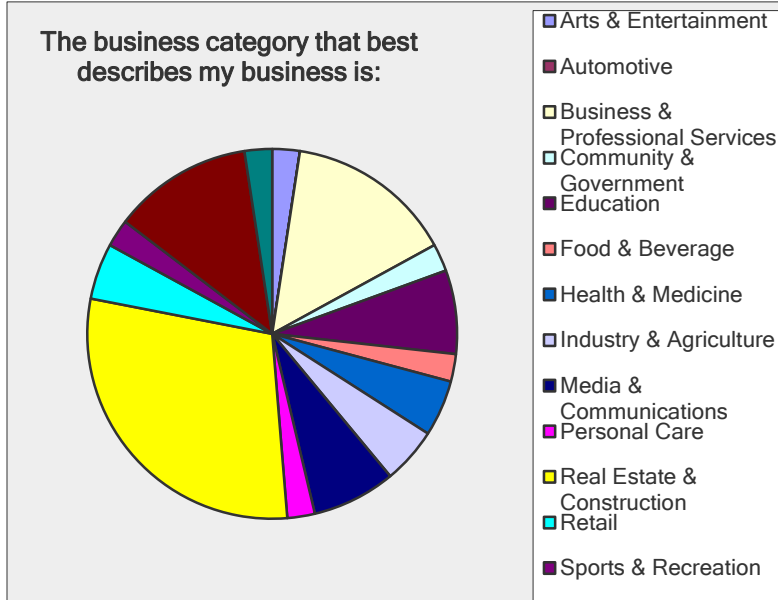
#7 - What is your favorite song or piece of music?

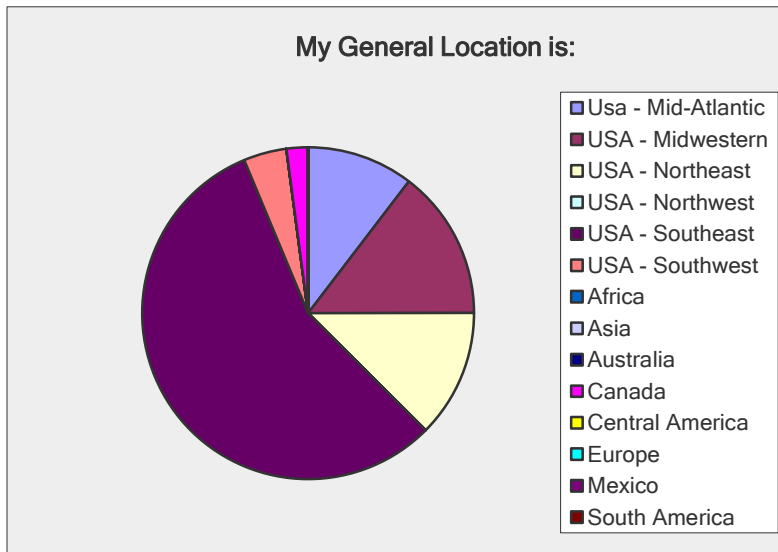
Demographics

#8 - Business Category - The top three groups were Real Estate and Construction with 29.3%, Business and Professional Services with 14.6% and Technology with 12.2%



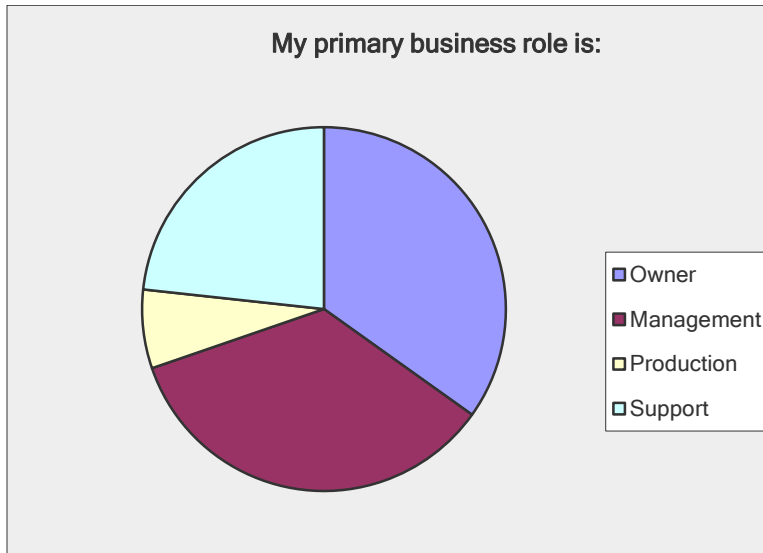
#9 - General Location
